

ICAR's Special National Swachhta Campaign on Waste to Health

ICAR- National Research Centre on Seed Spices, Ajmer observed Swachhta Campaign on Waste to Health on dated 12.10.2021. Under this campaign institute organized various activities. A Swachhta campaign was organized at institute campus of ICAR-National Research Centre on Seed Spices, Ajmer. Sr. Sec School Saradhana Ajmer by ICAR-National Research Centre on Seed Spices, Ajmer on dated 12.10.2021. In the programme school students of 10 to 12 standard from nearby villages like Dumara, Tabiji, Saradhna, Kesarpura, Makreda, Mayapur Nadi Mangliyawas etc. were present.
