

## ICAR-NRCSS organized Training cum Field Day under MIDH

A one day farmers training cum field day on “Promoting GAP & IPM based Cumin Production System” Under MIDH was organized at village Katyasani Dist. Nagaur (Rajasthan) on 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. In programme 85 farmers including female farmers participated from Katyasani and nearby villages. Participants were educated on improved cumin production technologies with emphasis on minimal use of chemicals in this crop. To harvest better prices in cumin they were educated on better marketing practices with proper cleaning and grading of produce and sale at right market in right time. The cumin crop grown under guidance of ICAR-NRCSS was demonstrated to the participants with comparison to local fields in nearby area.
